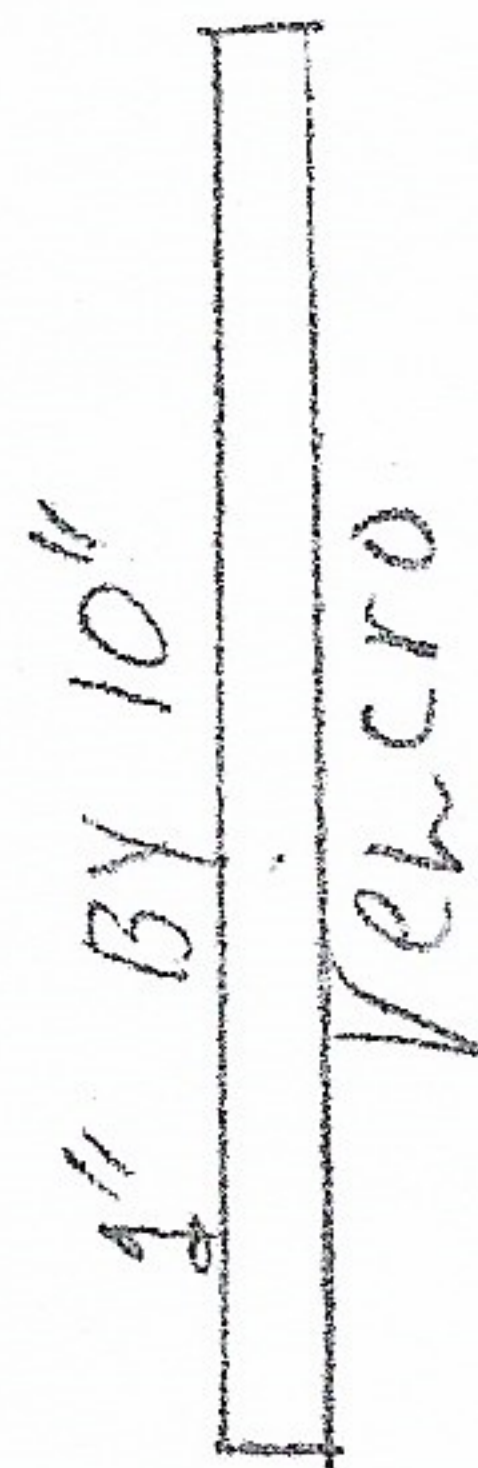
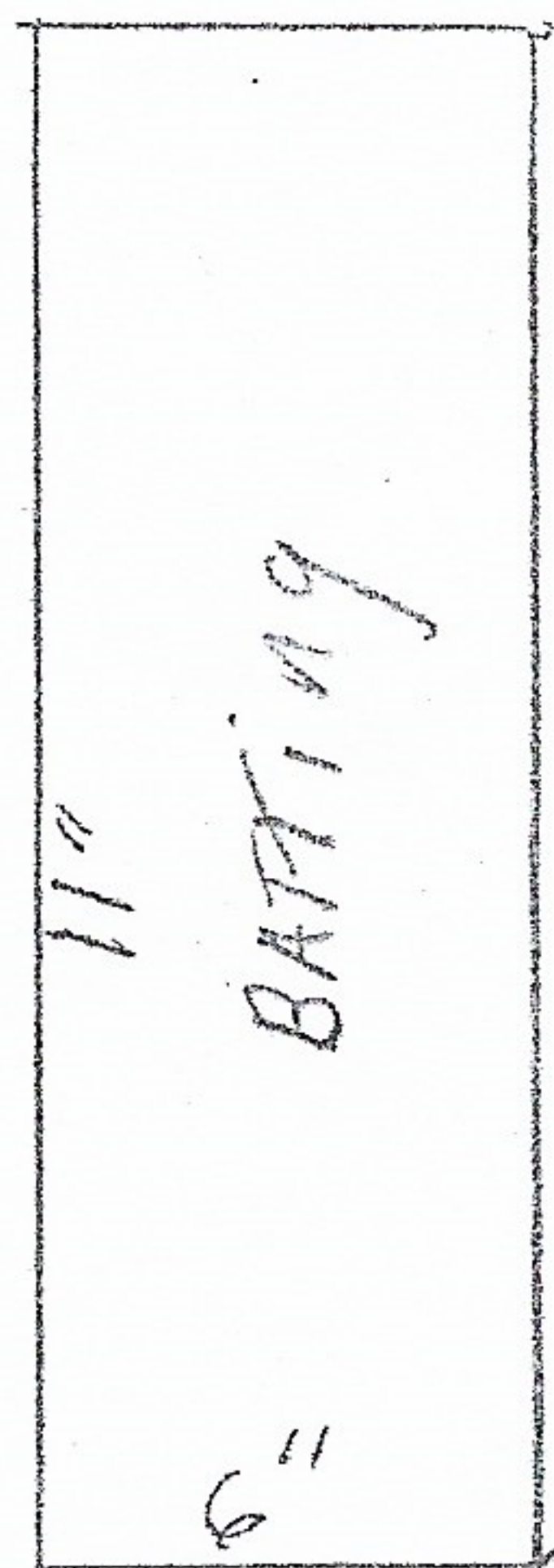
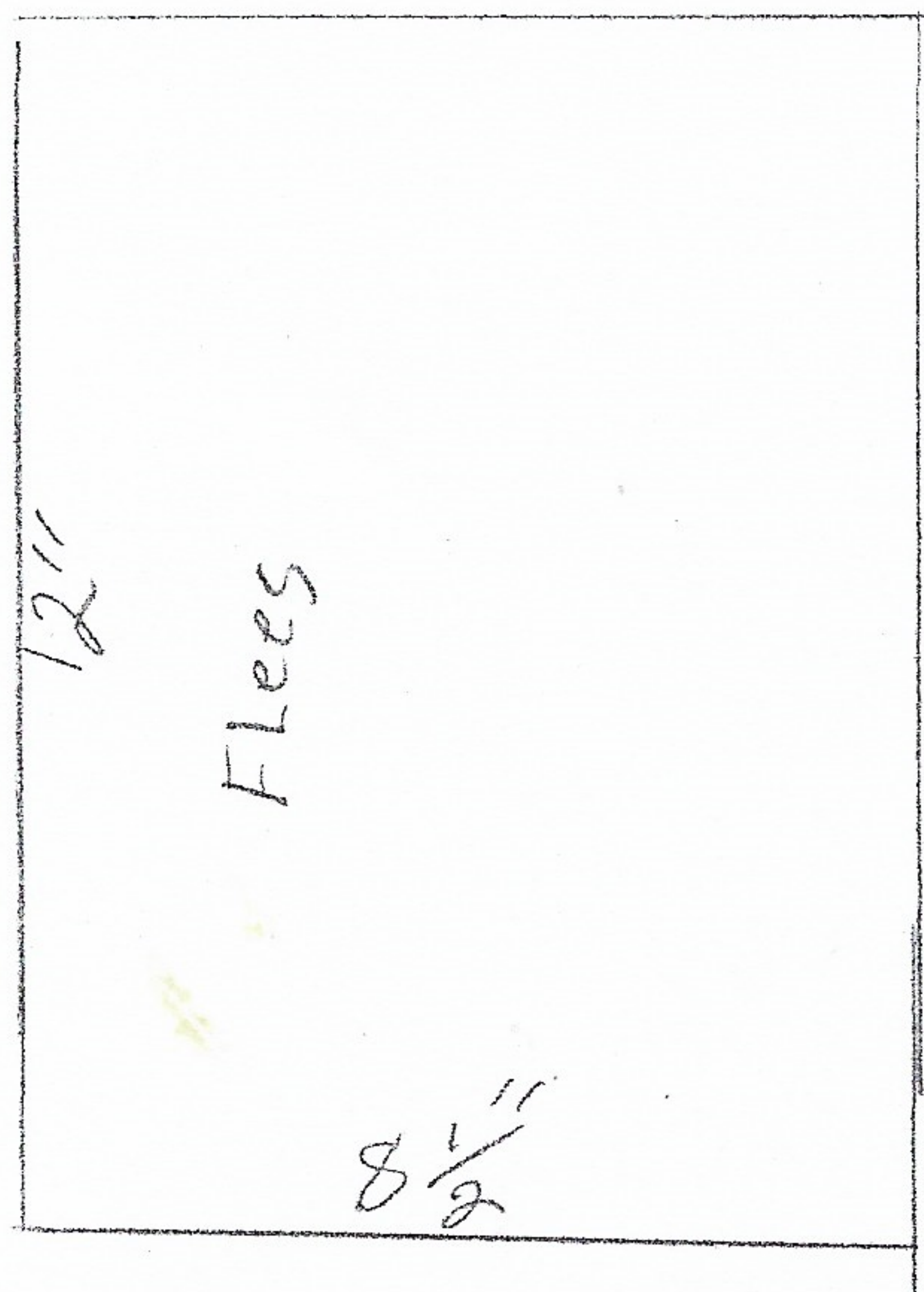


Seat Belt Covers



Materials

Velcro, heavy pial fabric

(Minke, flees,) also flannel

Cut your fabric into 12- inch by 8 1/2-inch rectangles one of heavy fabric and one of flannel. take the flannel and put two layers of quilt batting 11 by 6 inch in the center sew it down on all four sides. Lay the heavy fabric on the top wrong sides together so on three sides on the 4th side leave an opening so you can turn it right side out. Turn it right side out press out your corners and your seams iron flat top stains around the edges close your opening. take a 10 1/2- inch piece of Velcro and so it one inch in from your long side Put the loops on one side of the fabric put the hooks on the other side of the fabric so that when you wrap it around it closes. You now have a completed seat belt cover.
