Each quilt may be entered in one category only. (See Definitions below) Entry must have been made by one or two persons (includes the quilter) in all categories except Categories 8-Group Quilt and 19-Display only.

QUILT CATEGORIES

1. **Applique:** All Sizes, Stationary Machine Quilting
2. **Applique:** All Sizes, Movable Machine Quilting
3. **Applique:** All Sizes, Computer Generated Quilting.
4. **Hand Quilted:** All sizes, all techniques, must be predominantly hand quilted.
5. **Art/Innovative:** All sizes, all quilting methods.
6. **Modern:** All sizes, all quilting methods.
7. **Miniature:** Wall, all quilting methods. Size cannot exceed W 24" L 24"
8. **Group:** Three or more makers, all sizes, all quilting methods.
9. **TRQG Challenge:** Guild members only.
10. **Small:** W 24-60" L 24-60"

12. **Small:** W 24-60", L 24-60",

16. **Large:** W 84-110" L greater than 84",

18. **Large:** W 84-110", L greater than 84",
Computer Generated Quilting.
19. **Display only:** Not judged.

PIECING CATEGORY DEFINITIONS

- **Applique:** Applique predominates over other piecing techniques in amount or effect.
- **Hand Quilted:** May be hand or machine pieced, but predominantly Hand Quilted.
- **Art/Innovative:** Must be your **Original Design & work**, reflecting innovative constructions, design technique, theme or subject matter and/or materials. **No commercial patterns.** Must be made of fabric, three layers, and contain quilting, hand or machine.
- **Modern Quilt:** Primarily functional, inspired by modern design, usually incorporating the use of bold colors and prints, high contrast, graphic areas of solid color, improvisational piecing, minimalism, expansive negative space, and alternate grid work.
- **Miniature:** A *Miniature* is a scaled-down version of all features of a large quilt design. Neither the width nor length can exceed 24 inches.

QUILTING CATEGORY DEFINITIONS

The appropriate category selection should reflect the majority quilting technique used on the quilt.

- **Stationary Machine Quilting:** Machine quilting that requires the quilters to move the fabric beneath the machine head to create a stitched design. (AKA Free Motion Quilting)
- **Moveable Machine Quilting:** Machine quilting that requires the quilter to move the head of the machine over the quilt to create a stitched design.
- **Computer Generated Quilting:** Quilting is predominantly a computerized/digital design stitched onto the quilt. Can be Long/Mid-arm or via an Embroidery Machine.
