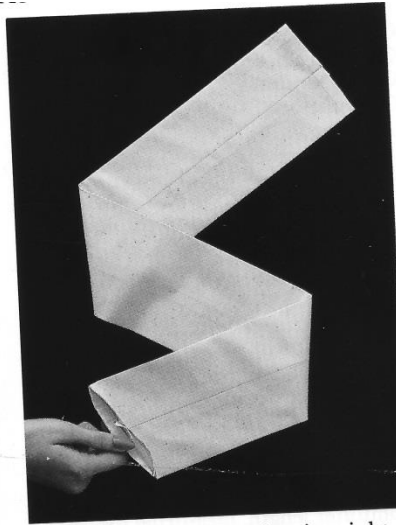


## How to Hang a Quilt Using a Fabric Sleeve

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**1)** Cut piece of washed, unbleached muslin, 10" (25.5 cm) wide by the width of the quilt. Turn under and stitch double  $\frac{1}{2}$ " (1.3 cm) hems at short ends.



**2)** Stitch long edges of strip, right sides together, using  $\frac{1}{2}$ " (1.3 cm) seam; press seam allowances open. Turn sleeve right side out; press flat, centering seam along back.



**3)** Pin sleeve to back of quilt, close to edges. Blindstitch sleeve to quilt along top and bottom edges; stitch through backing and batting. Insert sealed wooden lattice through sleeve, not between quilt and sleeve.
